Dress Code

General Rules:

- All Students are expected to attend class wearing their AYDT Class Uniform.
- Hair must be pulled away from the face with sturdy hair elastics and barrettes. Long hair must be worn in a ponytail. Students in all Graded Level Ballet Classes & Open Level Ballet Classes must wear hair in a bun. (If you do not know how to make a bun, instructions will be given on the first day of class.)
- No headbands, scrunchies or other flimsy hair accessories.
- Close fitting sweaters are permitted during cold weather.
- No costumes or dress-up clothes.

Ballet:

Girls:

- Pink leotard for Mommy-n-Me, Tiny Tots and Pre-Ballet
- Black leotard for Graded Level Ballet & Open Level Ballet
- Pink tights
- Pink ballet slippers
- Tutus are allowed in Mommy-n-Me and Tiny Tots only. No costume or dress up-clothes permitted

Tap:

Girls:

Tap/Jazz Intro, Tap 1A:

- Black leotard
- Tan tights
- Black patent tap shoes (Tap/Jazz Intro students also wear ballet slippers for the jazz part of the class)

All other Tap levels:

- Black leotard
- Black dance pants
- Black split sole tap shoes

Boys (all levels):

- Black dance t-shirt
- Black dance pants
- Black tap shoes (Tap/Jazz Intro students also wear ballet slippers for the jazz part of the class)

Hip Hop:

- Black dance t-shirt
- Black hip hop pants
- Black Hip Hop shoes

Broadway:

- Black leotard
- Black dance pants
- Tan Jazz shoes
