Rules & Policies

Art In Motion Cancellation and Attendance Policies

- Your child is not considered to be enrolled until both the Registration Form and Release Form have been completed and submitted with your payment.
- Cancellation Policy: If you cancel up to 14 days before the first day of any camp week, we will refund the entire tuition and keep only the registration fee and any uniform payment (uniforms may not be returned). After that, however, we will retain 25% of the tuition. If you are dissatisfied with the program at the end of the first day and you drop out, you will be charged for one day only as well as the registration fee. No refunds will be given after the first day.
- *Art in Motion* reserves the right to cancel a week's session due to low registration. In the unlikely event that a week is cancelled, every effort will be made to switch the student to an appropriate alternative week. If student is unable to switch to a different week, full tuition will be refunded in the case of cancellation by *Art in Motion* only.
- Due to the intensive summer schedule, we regret that no make-ups can be provided if your child is absent.
- Camp costs will not be prorated due to absences.

American Youth Dance Theater Safety and Etiquette Rules

- **Dancewear and shoes purchased at AYDT are non-returnable.**
- Please be aware that a long, steep staircase leads straight up to our lobby. The stairs should be ascended and descended slowly and carefully while holding the hand rails. **Children must be accompanied by a parent or caregiver at all times** and may not go up or down the stairs without a parent or guardian.
- Our entry way is also our exit and a Fire Exit and therefore **strollers must be completely folded and hung on the provided racks to allow for easy access for everyone. If for any reason you require assistance when you arrive** please let us know through the intercom system at the front door and wait until someone comes downstairs to assist you.
- Please observe proper Dress/Hair Code. No costumes, tutus or dress-up clothes.
- Parents should pick up children promptly after camp and advise teacher if someone else will be picking up your child.
- Please place belongings neatly in the dressing rooms, keeping valuables with you. AYDT is not responsible for any items lost or stolen anywhere on premises.
- Windows in studio doors are provided for quick and quiet viewing of ongoing classes. Blinds may be pulled closed during class at teacher's discretion if students are being distracted by outside activity.
- No street shoes in the studio.
- Please keep voices low in the waiting area and be courteous to other people's ears if you need to use your cell phone.
- No food or drinks on the premises (except water).

The Art Center Safety and Etiquette Rules

- Please do not congregate outside The Art Center at any time. This is very important to our landlord and our neighbors.
- If you or your sitters need to wait while your child is at The Art Center, we do have a small waiting area inside. Space is somewhat limited, so please be considerate of others while using this space. No loud talking and no cell phones, please.
- Children arriving early for CAMP must be accompanied by an adult. Please do not leave children unattended while waiting for camp to begin or end. Children cannot be allowed to run around the space or create a disturbance. If there is a persistent disturbance you will be asked to leave until dismissal time.
- Help us keep the waiting area clean. Deposit all leftover food and other trash in the can provided. Please ask your sitters to help clean up after children who may forget.
- Please do not bring pets into the building when picking up children.
- Please do not bring peanuts, other nuts, or peanut butter into the building. It is a peanut-free zone. Some children are extremely allergic and even touching peanut butter can send them to the emergency room.
